The Department of Neurosurgery at the University of Illinois at Chicago would like to invite you to attend the Neurovascular Symposium 2008 to be held on Saturday October 4th, 2008. The symposium will focus on existing and emerging therapies for patients with cerebrovascular disease, including management and prevention of ischemic stroke, the latest in endovascular and surgical aneurysm treatment, and strategies for stroke care delivery. The range of topics promise to provide for a great educational event with much opportunity for discussion.

The symposium will feature a renowned group of experts, with guest faculty reflecting a multidisciplinary background. Speakers include prominent UIC faculty from Neurology, Neurointensive Care, Neuroendovascular, Neurosurgery, and Neuropsychology. We also have the distinct pleasure of hosting C.A.F. Tulleken, MD, PhD from Utrecht, the Netherlands, as the special honored guest. Professor Tulleken is a widely respected neurosurgical pioneer in the development of new techniques in intracranial-extracranial bypass, and will discuss the genesis and applications of non-occlusive laser-assisted bypass surgery.

- Describe current medical and endovascular therapies for ischemic stroke
- Discuss recent advances in the management of cerebral aneurysms
- Describe assessment and management of stroke in the acute setting and during recovery
- Evaluate options for stroke care delivery

The one-day meeting is appropriate for health care professionals involved in the care of patients at risk for cerebrovascular disease, including primary care physicians, internists, emergency room physicians, neurologists, interventional neuroradiologists, neurosurgeons, critical care specialists, physical medicine and rehabilitation physicians, and nurses.

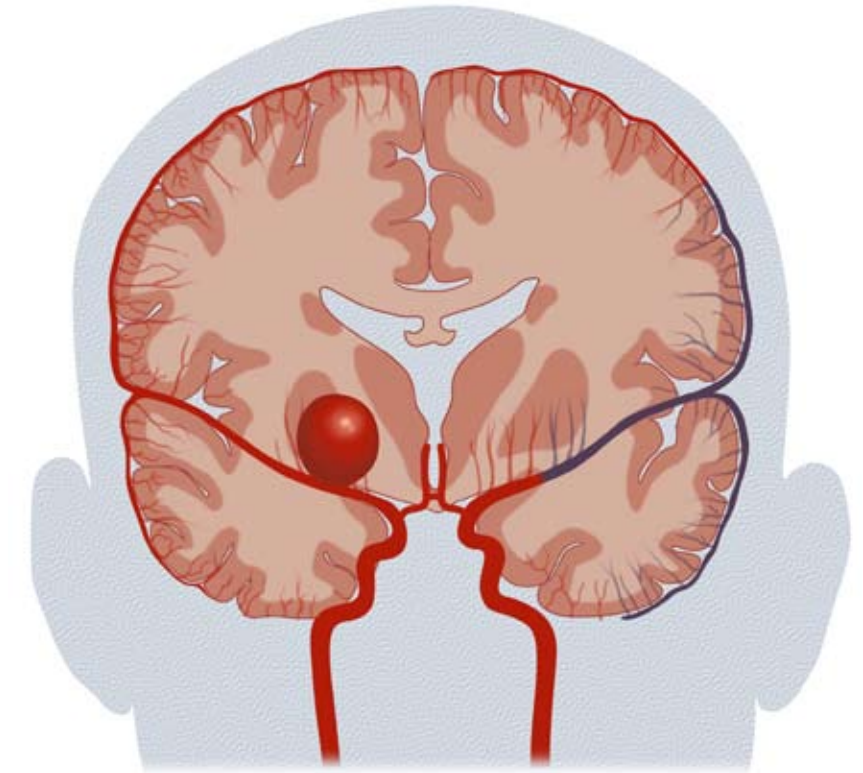
